

**Monday, June 12 – Thursday, June 15, 2017**

*Will you strive to safeguard the integrity of God's creation and respect, sustain, and renew the life of the earth?*

Through a daily cycle of prayer, reflection, silence, and response, we will both individually and as a group explore how we can safeguard God's creation.
