

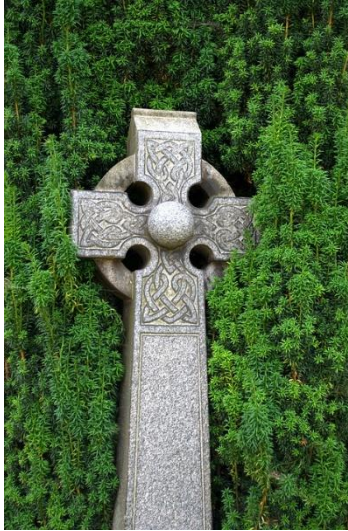
Happy Thursday!
