READERS GROUP at St. Paul’s, 10 a.m. Sunday Morning Service

The Readers Group is a dedicated group of approximately twenty-six members of our 10 a.m. congregation who take turns in groups of two to read the lessons each Sunday at the ten o’clock service. One reads the Old Testament reading followed by the chosen Psalm for the day, and the other reads the New Testament selection. Readers are assigned in advance on a rotating basis in a three or four month ‘block’ usually related to a Holy Season. The schedule requires each member to read once every three months or so, and the group is always flexible enough to allow for personal reasons or illness.

The group generally finds the preparation for presenting the lessons to be personally rewarding and gives each of us some ‘insight’ and background as to the message delivered through the sermon for that day.

Reading is an enjoyable task that is rewarding and enlightening. We encourage each other to practice the lesson presentation at home prior to the Sunday we are to read.
