Parish Ministries of St. Paul's Cathedral – The Sunday School

We are blessed at St. Paul's with an amazing group of children and youth who participate in our Sunday School program. Our Sunday School classes are taught by a team of amazing and dedicated teachers – we are so fortunate to have all of these wonderful children, youth, parents and teachers in our midst!

The Sunday School program takes place during the Sunday morning 10am Family Eucharist Service in the lower level of the facility from September – June each year. Children arrive at church with their families and are a part of the congregation until our 'Children's Sacred Square'.

Our Children, Youth and Family Life Ministry Coordinator develops a lectionary-based program with story, crafts, songs, and activities that complement what the adults learn in church as it is based on the same scripture and themes. Parents are very welcome to join us in Sunday School if they like. Later in the service we return upstairs to share in the Eucharist with our families.

Our Sunday School is very dedicated to outreach ministry, this is an intentional part of our class time together. Giving to world relief, making soup and cookies for our hungry neighbours, and providing warm hats, mitts and socks on the Christmas Giving tree for the Out of the Cold Shelter program, are some of the things that teach us about caring and sharing with others.

We always welcome new teachers and anyone who would like to be a "Helping Hand" on a regular or part time basis. If you have a talent you would like to share with the children such as crafts, music, cooking, outreach projects, or putting on plays such as the Christmas pageant, you would be most welcome and appreciated. We are always open to new ideas and people to join this important ministry team.
