Youth and Young People



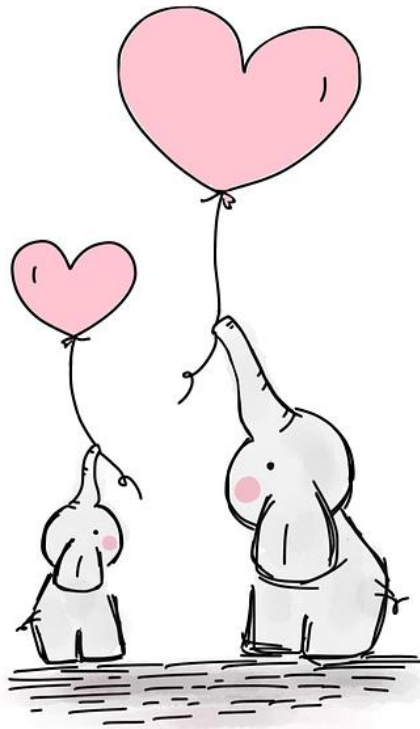
Children's Ministry will be taking place this Sunday during the 10am service. Join Melissa as we hear a story that will help us to remember that God is always listening.
